Footlight Theatre's Vaudeville Varieties - Theatrical Hijinks – Come see the antics these entertainers get up to!

Sylvia the Balloon Lady - whimsical balloon creations made right before your eyes then given away to children.

Heritage Toys - Visit Elworth garage and play with the replica heritage toys. Just like in olden days, all these toys were handmade out of wood. They include: ball & cup, Jacob's ladder, drumming bear, and periscopes.

Tin Pan Trio

This trio is a real crowd pleaser. Tap your toes to the engaging sounds of this Dixie land Jazz trio. These costumed musicians play a banjo, base and snare drum. Their repertoire includes tunes from the 1920s.

Apple Peeling - It is harvest time and the apples are ripe and ready to be peeled. Come to Elworth kitchen and use an old apple peeler that peels and slices your apple, then take it with you as a nice and refreshing snack. One per child, but I'm sure they will share with Mom and Dad.

Watermelon Eating Contest - What's better than a slice of fresh watermelon on a hot summer day? How fast can you eat a large slice of watermelon? Compete for ribbons.

Face Painting - Always a favourite with children of all ages

Baking & Vegetable Judging – which apple pie will take home the blue ribbon? Children compete with decorated sugar cookies. Find an odd shaped vegetable in the garden? Bring it in, you might win a prize. BVM brings back the home baking and vegetable judging competitions – a favourite at every country fair.
