DOG LICENCES

Every person who owns a dog in Burnaby is required to ensure that it wears a valid licence tag. Dog tags go on sale December 01. Annual licence fees are:

	<u>Before March 1st and for new dogs</u>	<u>After March 1st</u>
Each spayed/neutered dog	\$15.00	\$25.00
Each unaltered dog	\$40.00	\$50.00

Please be aware that Burnaby has a limit of two (2) dogs per household and that your dog must be kept on a leash when in a public place. If your dog is impounded, it will be held at the Burnaby Animal Shelter for 72 hours and may be claimed with proof of ownership and payment of impound fees.

Permanent off-leash areas are designated at the north end of Confederation Park, in Robert Burnaby Park near the lower parking lot and in Fraser Foreshore Park along Byrne Creek. Seasonal off-leash areas (October to March) are located in designated areas at the west end of Barnet Marine Park and near the Fraser Foreshore Park picnic area, west of Byrne Road.

Dog owners in Burnaby are responsible for removing their dog's excrement from property other than their own and disposing of it on their property or in a sanitary manner.
