

Torch Relay Route - Burnaby

Thursday, February 11, 2010

Temporary rolling road closures will be necessary along this route to allow the Olympic torchbearers and support vehicles to pass through Burnaby. We appreciate your patience as this once in a lifetime event occurs.

At 10:45am, the formal program at the 1920s-style Burnaby Village Museum will begin. The torch will make a two-minute ceremonial stop as part of the program. Attendees can explore Canada's gold medal past at the Village where activities will include entertainment from neighbouring schools, two costumed interpreters wearing replicas of the 1924 Olympic ceremonial uniform for Canada – the year of the first Winter Olympics – and a family scavenger hunt.

With 4,000 people expected to attend, the community is advised to take public transit to the Burnaby Village Museum and arrive early. Organizers are also asking attendees to show their spirit by wearing red and white to the celebration. The gates to the Museum will be open to the public, free of charge from 9:30am to 1:30pm.
